known work like the Bible will be more effective for a broad audience than an allusion to an obscure philosophical text, which a select few. Authors must carefully consider their audience when choosing allusions, aiming for a balance between meaningfulness and accessibility.

• While a well-chosen allusion can significantly enhance the meaning and depth of a text, even a seemingly decorative allusion can contribute to the overall aesthetic effect, creating a sense of richness and complexity.
